

Smoke-Free Environment Policy

Patrons & staff of the Kimberly-Little Chute Public Library have the right to use materials and services without being unduly disturbed or impeded by other users. Smoking and second-hand smoke pose a health risk and create an unpleasant environment for non-smokers.

Policy

1. The use of all tobacco-related products (smoking and smokeless) is prohibited in the library, as the library adopts the respective Village policies governing cigarettes and smoking on Village property. This includes, but is not limited to, smoking, rolling cigarettes, and using e-cigarettes (“vaping”).
2. Staff who observe persons in violation should see that they are informed of this policy and ask them to comply. In the case of non-compliance, staff may ask patrons to leave library property until they comply or summon the Police to cite violators for trespassing, if necessary. Repeat or flagrant offenders may forfeit library use privileges.
